Don't Forget to Change Your Smoke Detector Batteries and Test Each Smoke Detector In Your Home

For years the NFPA has recommended that we change the batteries in our smoke detectors and test them twice a year —usually around the same time that we change our clocks for DST in the spring and fall of each year.

As you know, beginning in 2007, daylight saving time (DST) has been extended four weeks in the United States. In 2007 DST started on March 11th, which is three weeks earlier than usual, and it will end on November 4, 2007, which is one week later than usual.
