Alfred Station Volunteer Fire Company recently welcomed two new members. Joining the department are June Kenyon of Alfred Station (joined in May) and Dave Williams of Alfred Station (joined in June). These two members bring a great deal of enthusiasm and experience to the company. June, a Firefighter and Emergency Medical Technician formerly of the Almond Fire Department is a Rural Mail Carrier for the Almond Post Office. In other business, the Alfred Station Fire Company responded to 10 calls in the month of June: six automatic fire alarms on the Alfred University Campus, two calls involving downed trees/power lines, one motor vehicle accident and one call assisting the Alfred Police Department in finding a missing child. This brings Alfred Station's emergency call total to 88 emergency calls through the month of June 2004. This is a huge increase compared to last year's recording setting year of 100 calls total.
