Alfred Station Volunteer Fire Company recently welcomed three new members. Joining the department are: Brian Dodge of Alfred Station, Andy Cline of Belmont and Cathy Williams of Alfred Station. Brian and Andy both are 2005 graduates from Alfred Almond Central School and have been members of Alfred Station Fire Company's Junior Firefighter Explorer Program. The two are currently attending class to receive their Firefighter 1 certification. Cathy works at Tinkertown Hardware and has been a friend and supporter of the company since her sons Jason and Mathew joined the Junior Firefighter Program in 2003 and her husband David joined the company in 2004. All three new members bring a range of experience to the company and are looking forward to serving our community. In other business, the Alfred Station Fire Company responded to 16 calls in the month of May: 13 automatic fire alarms (11 at Alfred University and 2 at Alfred State College), 1 call for a broken gas line on Rte 244 in Alfred Station, 1 call to standby for Andover Fire Dept, and 1 mutual aid call with Almond Fire Dept for traffic control on I-86. This, combined with calls through June 15th, brings Alfred Station's emergency call total to 111 emergency responses year to date compared to 2004 when Alfred Station reached 111 responses in September.
